This completed application must be submitted to the Springtown Chamber office by 5:00 p.m. on **Friday, September 17, 2021.**

Wild West Festival Parade Rules:

Please share these rules with all your parade participants!

1. Parade participants **MAY NOT** throw any kind of candy/souvenirs from a float, vehicle or horseback. Parade participants **MAY** walk along the edge of the street and **HAND OUT** candy/souvenirs.
2. No parade entry is allowed to stop their vehicle during the parade route. If your vehicle begins to overheat, please pull out of the parade line as safely as possible.
3. **ONLY 16' TRAILERS OR SMALLER** will be allowed because of tight turns.
4. All Horse & Horse & Trailer entries must have Coggins Test Papers available.

GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION:

NO PARKING ADJACENT TO FLOATS— Please instruct float riders to **DROP OFF** at Springtown First Baptist Church Family Life building and walk to their float.

Parade Staging Area:

- **Cars, Tractors, Walkers & Floats:** ENTER ONLY ON AVENUE A AT BACK OF First Baptist Church and proceed down to your designated Float location.
- **Horses, Wagons & Trailers:** Will stage at Porcupine Stadium. Horses and riders will travel East on Holbrook to 5th Street then left to gravel parking lot across the street from First Baptist Church.
- **Sound of Springtown Marching Band:** will stage at Fundamental Baptist Church

Parade Route:

Parade staging and point of origin is located at First Baptist Church parking lot located at corner of East 5th Street and North Main Street. Parade will enter North Main Street from the 100 block of East 5th Street. The parade will proceed southbound to 1st Street. At 1st Street the parade will turn eastbound and travel to Avenue D turning northbound. The parade will conclude at the Tabernacle but all participating in the parade will continue northbound on Avenue D back to the First Baptist Church parking lot.

1. All entries must be in good taste.
2. Absolutely **NO** political entries will be allowed in the parade.
3. Please submit form by September 16, 2021.
4. Parade position will be based on category and no numbers will be assigned.
5. Parade Staging will be from 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. (First Baptist Church).
6. Parade begins at 10:00 a.m.
7. **NO OFF LOADING** of float riders will be permitted anywhere along the parade route.
8. All Floats will off load riders at First Baptist Church parking lot.
9. **LATE** arrivals will be placed at END of parade!! No Exceptions!!
